### INTRODUCTION TO MESHTASTIC

The Meshtastic Web Client is a browser-based app that allows you to control and communicate with your Meshtastic devices directly from your web browser. You can access the hosted version or self-host the Web Client on your local server.

# **Key Features:**


- Hosted Version: Use the web client directly from client.meshtastic.org.
- Self-Hosting: Set up your own Meshtastic Web Client on a server.
- Compatible Browsers: The web client works in all major browsers, with optimal performance on Chromiumbased browsers like Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge.

### GETTING STARTED WITH MESHTASTIC WEB CLIENT

- Accessing the Web Client: Use the hosted version by navigating to client.meshtastic.org in your browser.
   Alternatively, self-host the Web Client by following the instructions on the GitHub page (Meshtastic GitHub).
- Compatibility: The Web Client works best with Chromium-based browsers (e.g., Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge). Bluetooth and USB connections work in these browsers.

## Connecting via Bluetooth or Serial (USB):

- Bluetooth: Use Web Bluetooth API for connecting via Bluetooth (available in Chromium-based browsers).
- USB (Serial): Connect directly to the device via USB using the Web Serial API, though platform support is limited.



## CONNECTING YOUR DEVICE TO THE WEB CLIENT

### Via Bluetooth:


- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your computer.
- Click the "Connect" button in the Web Client to find your
  Meshtastic device. (The default Bluetooth password is 123456.)

## Via USB (Serial):

- Plug in your Meshtastic device to your computer via USB.
- The Web Client will recognize the device through the Web Serial API.


# Via HTTP (for esp32 devices):

- You can also connect via HTTP using the IP address of your device, though it's limited to esp32 devices.
- Once connected, the Web Client will display a cloud icon, showing the connection status.




## **CONFIGURING YOUR DEVICE VIA WEB CLIENT**

- Set Device Region: In the Settings menu, select the Region that corresponds to your device's location for correct frequency settings.
- Change Device Name: Set a unique name for your
  Meshtastic device to easily identify it in your network.
- Additional Settings: Configure any other device settings, such as message types and node information.



## SENDING AND RECEIVING MESSAGES

- Private Messages: Navigate to the Messages tab, select a contact or device, type your message, and hit Send.
- Broadcast Messages: Use the Broadcast option to send messages to all connected devices in your network.
- View Messages: Incoming messages are displayed in the Messages tab, showing both private and broadcast messages.



### TROUBLESHOOTING AND SUPPORT

## COMMON ISSUES:

- Device Not Connecting: Ensure your device is powered on and within range. Check the Bluetooth or USB connection settings.
- Messages Not Sending: If messages are not sending, check the cloud icon for connection status. Ensure the Web Client is properly connected to your device.
- Bluetooth Issues: Make sure your browser supports Web Bluetooth. If the connection fails, try restarting the app or browser.
